Here are five fabulous accounts worth adding to your stable of fine jewelry feeds. These industry insiders (and influencers) document new collections, trends, and jewelry news daily.

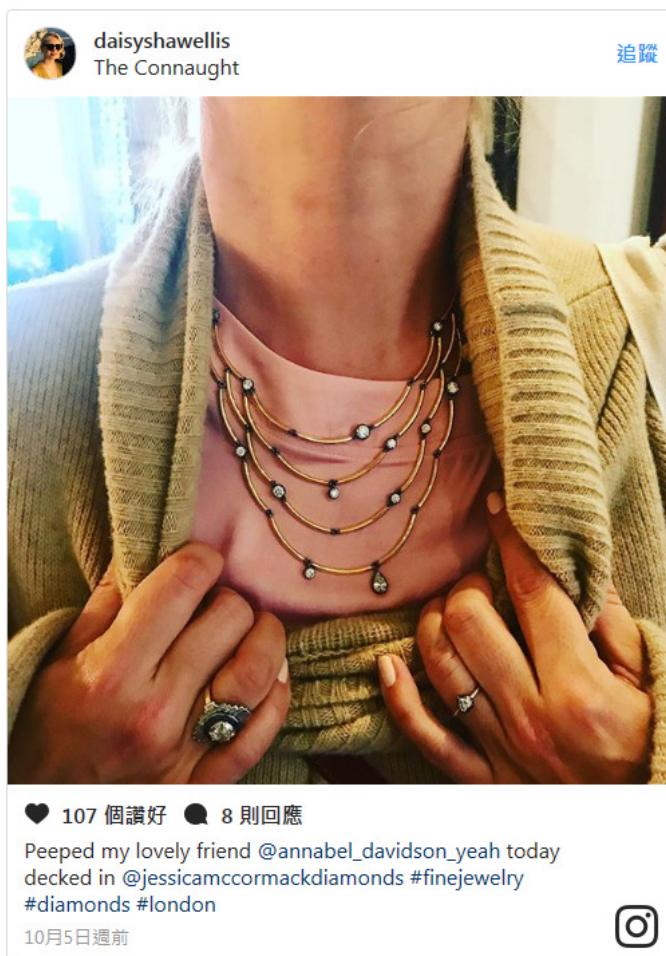
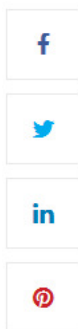
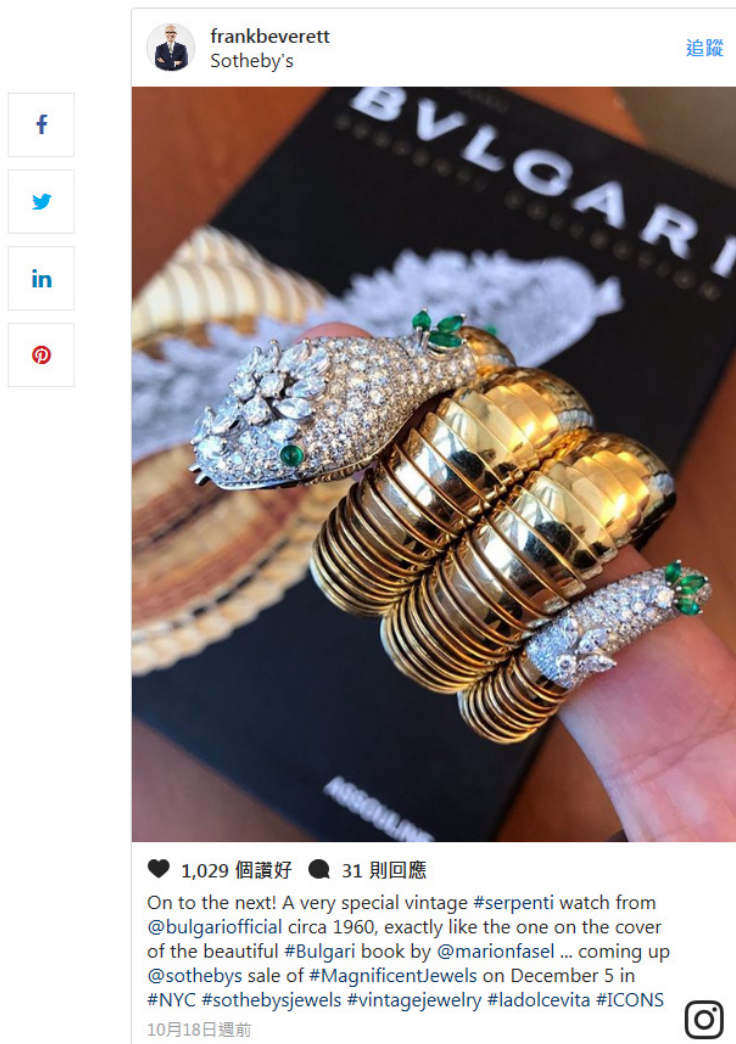

Muse reps a collection of exciting jewelry designers, including Holly Dyment and Silvia Furmanovitch, and the firm's feed is full of envelope-pushing design.

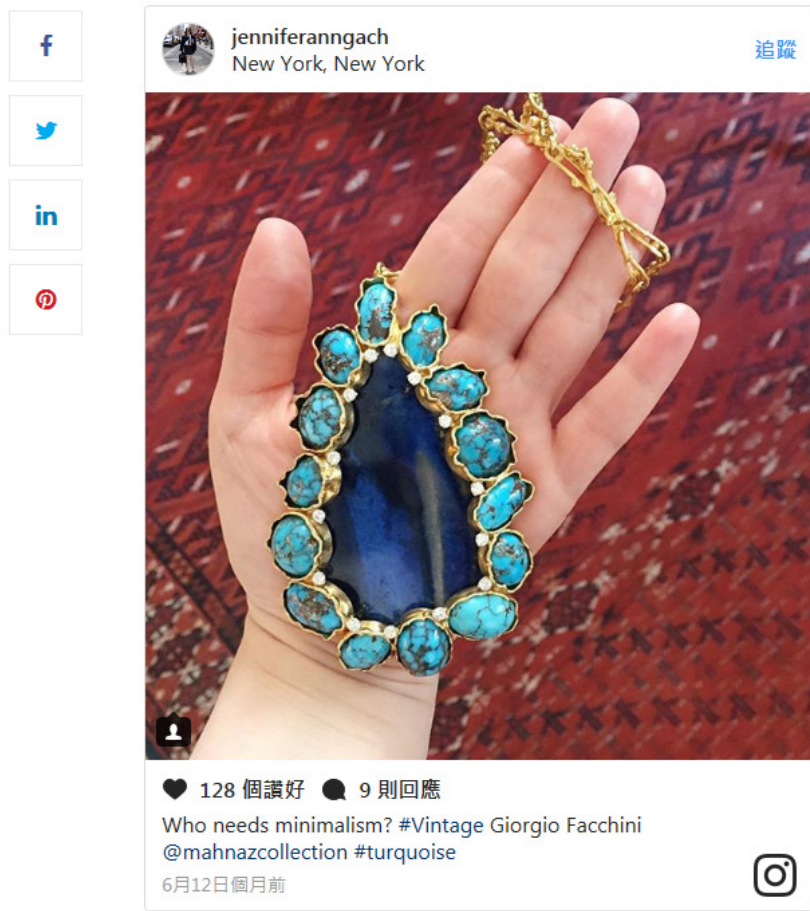
